Chemistry Scholarships

Indiana State University

The following scholarships are available to **ISU chemistry majors**. Some of them have special stipulations that are noted below. The approximate amount of each award may vary somewhat from year to year because of fluctuations in the earnings of the endowments.

Dr. Donald J. Reuland Scholarship: Awarded to a major with superior performance in chemistry. One award of about \$1000.

Dr. Earl C. Smith Scholarship: This scholarship is given to a student who has just completed the sophomore year. It is based on the student's academic performance in CHEM 105, 106, 352, 352L, and also in 321 if already taken. One award of about \$1000.

William H. Bell Award in Chemistry: No special stipulations. One award of about \$1200, or two awards of about \$600 each, or three awards of about \$400 each.

Dr. William B. Bunger Scholarship: No special stipulations. One award of about \$500 or two awards of about \$250 each.

Dr. Leonard C. Smith Memorial Scholarship: The recipient must have completed two years at ISU and must have demonstrated an interest in biochemistry. One award of about \$750 or two awards of about \$375.

Dr. William G. Kessel Memorial Scholarship: No special stipulations. One award of about \$200.

Dr. Paul D. Wilkinson Memorial Scholarship: The recipient must be a full time student who has a financial need and must receive no other awards. One award of about \$100.

Donald and Mary Jo Stanley Scholarship: This scholarship has some stipulations for which a student must sign a *terms of consideration* form (the box below). From four to eight awards of \$500 to \$1500 each.

In applying for a Stanley Scholarship, I recognize that the criteria to receive an award include that I...

- am or will be enrolled at ISU;
- am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Indiana;
- refrain from the use of controlled drugs, tobacco, and alcohol;
- refrain from participation in intercollegiate athletics;
- was in the upper 25% of my high school class;
- maintain at least a B grade point average in college.

I acknowledge that my student academic, financial, and disciplinary records will be subject to review by the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.
